
POP UP ARCADE SEND ACCOMADATIONS PACK



Here are some of the ways we can help make sure everyone has a fantastic time at our parties and events:

- We can arrange a phone call before the party to discuss any access needs/preferences.
- Extra time can be added at beginning of the party (before guests arrive) for the birthday child to meet the gamesmaster, spend time playing the games by themselves/get some one to one coaching and check out the set up to help them feel comfortable/secure so they can enjoy the party.
- Parents are welcome to stay if it will make players feel more comfortable or if they need additional support. We encourage them to join in playing!
- Additional screens and consoles can be added if any players may find taking turns/sharing

difficult.

- Players are welcome to take breaks or come and go as they please (with appropriate supervision)
- Our party structure is completely flexible. Players can play freely on the games they prefer rather than in a structured tournament if they find competition stressful or we can run to a set structure if this will make them more comfortable.
- Our set up is completely flexible. We can set up in a familiar space (eg: at home, in a hall used for after school club or similar) and in a way that facilitates player enjoyment (eg: allows them to play sitting or standing, can be more spread out to accommodate mobility devices or sensory needs).
- We can cater for players with a range of abilities/gaming experience to play together, for example kids from a large age range or with varying support needs.
- Our parties are scalable, ranging from 4 or 5 players (eg: family only or a couple of close friends for players that will be more comfortable with a smaller group) to over 20 people being able to play at the same time.
- We always provide a 5 and 10 minute warning to the end of the party/gaming. We can provide additional warnings if this will help the players prepare for the next part of the party.
- Players are welcome to bring/use any items or tools that will help them feel comfortable during the party (eg: ear defenders, wobble cushion, sensory items)
- Players of all ages (including older children, teens and adults) are welcome to enjoy our parties.
